I would like to draw your attention to Article 19 of the GDPR, which states that the data controller is obliged to inform all recipients to whom the personal data have been disclosed, unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort. Upon request of the data subject, the data controller shall inform these recipients. Furthermore, I would like to highlight Article 12, Paragraph 3 of the GDPR, which stipulates that the data controller is obligated to provide information in a concise, transparent, intelligible, and easily accessible form, using clear and plain language, within the shortest possible time, but no later than one month from the receipt of the request.(4)

Failure to fulfill or delay in fulfilling this obligation may result in the data subject lodging a complaint with the supervisory authority and exercising their right to judicial remedy, as stipulated in Article 12, Paragraph 4 of the GDPR.
